

what you **must** have in an extraction system:

- directly under the work area
- have unrestricted air draw
 (plates over the filter means less removal)
- independently tested dust survey
 (tested in a salon and by a separate company)
- ergonomic width of workstation - 550mm
- intrinsically safe motor
 (no spark as everything you use is flammable)
- whisper quiet
 (you need to talk to your clients)
- cost effectiveness for filter life
 (continual replacement of filters add costs)
- electrics attached to your workstation
 (to stop electrical cord crossover and trip hazards)
- easy to clean, hygienic, towel-less workarea safe from product damage
 (towels harbour dust and bacteria, chemicals can damage workstation surface)
